1. Divisions

Bioresource Production Science Applied Bioresource Science Rare Sugar Science

2. Qualification for Application

Applicants are required to meet at least one of the following qualifications.

- Applicants must have graduated from a university or college as provided by Clause 1, Article 83 of the School Education Law, Japan, or are expected to graduate by the end of March 2013.
- (2) Applicants must have received a Bachelor's degree as provided for by Clause 4, Article 104 of the School Education Law, Japan, or a degree from a technical college that is authorized by the National Institution for Academic Degrees, Japan by the end of March 2013.
- (3) Applicants must have completed a 16-year school education in foreign countries, or are expected to complete such an education by the end of March 2013.
- (4) Applicants must have completed a 16-year school education by taking a correspondence course offered by a foreign school and completing it in Japan, or are expected to complete such an education by the end of March 2013.
- (5) Applicants must have completed the courses designated in particular by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Japan, at an educational facility defined as one that has courses of foreign universities in the school educational system of the foreign country, or are expected to complete such courses by the end of March 2013. In addition to the above conditions, applicants must have completed a 16-year school education in a foreign country.

- (6) Applicants must have been designated as special cases or are expected to be applicable for such designation by the end of March 2013 by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology, Japan.
- (7) Applicants must have been selected by the Graduate School of Agriculture, Kagawa University from candidates who would be on the university or college register for more than 3 years at the end of March 2013.
- (8) Applicants must have entered other graduate schools as provided by Clause 2, Article 102 of the School Education Law, Japan, and have an academic attainment equal to or higher than that of a holder of a Bachelor's degree. The qualifications shall be examined by the Faculty Committee.
- (9) Applicants must have surpassed university or college graduates in scholastic ability, and have reached 22 years of age, or are going to be 22 years of age by the end of March 2013.

N.B.

Applicants who want to apply under qualification criteria (7), (8) or (9), must contact the Educational Affairs Section, Faculty of Agriculture, Kagawa University by November 30 (Fri), 2012.

3. Entrance Examination

Consideration will be given to all test results (Presentation and Interview), academic records, etc.

Exam of Presentation and Interview will be conducted in the appropriate Division.

(1) Application form:

Be sure to fill out all parts of the application.

(2) An academic record and a letter of recommendation: Be sure to fill out all parts of the form prescribed by each university.

(3) Statement of reason for application:

Be sure to fill out all parts of the prescribed form. Japanese or Foreign Government Scholarship Students at our University may submit a statement of plan for study at our Graduate School.

- (4) Certificate of graduation or of expected graduation
- (5) Summary of presentation

Be sure to follow the Presentation Summary Guidelines.

(6) Application fee (except those who obtain the Japanese Government Scholarship): 30,000 yen

Fill out necessary information on the application form and include the bank transfer form and the receipt. Payment may be made at a banking institution (except the Post Office) from December 5, 2012 to December 19, 2012. Be sure to get a stamp from the banking institution on the bottom-right column of the application form. Inquiries may be made at the Admission Division of School Affairs

- (7) Photograph: Paste your photograph on the designated part of the Picture Ticket. The photograph must have been taken within the past six months, be a bust-portrait with bare-head and full-face, 4cm \times 3cm.
- (8) Certificate of qualification as a foreign resident :
 A certificate of alien registration or a copy of visa, etc.
 - N.B. Research students in our University may submit copies for items (2), (3) and (4).
- 7. Announcement of Successful Candidates

The list of successful candidates will be posted at the Faculty at 10:00 on February 15(Fri), 2012. In addition, an offer of Admission will be sent to each successful candidate by mail.

8. Enrollment Procedure

The necessary documents and payment will be accepted between 9:00 and 17:00 from March. 26 (Tue), 2012 to March. 27 (Wed), 2012
