SPECIAL GRADUATE PROGRAMS (1)

Special Course from Asia, Africa and the Pacific Rim (Master course/ABE Initiative, United Graduate School Doctor course)

The Special Course from Asia, Africa and the Pacific Rim (**AAP Course**) is a graduate school program that accepts international students from the Asia-Africa Pacific Rim region and conducts **all classes and research guidance in English**. In addition to accepting privately funded international students, we also accept foreign students from African countries and other developing countries as part of the African Human Resources Development Program (ABE Initiative/JICA Long-term Trainee) and the Human Resources Development Program for Developing Countries in Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (JICA Agri-net).



SPECIAL GRADUATE PROGRAMS (2)

Career Development Special Program for Food Safety in Japan (Master course)

The Career Development Special Program for Food Safety in Japan (Master course) began as a joint project of the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) and Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT). Kagawa University formed a consortium with Japanese companies dealing with frozen foods or developing food resources overseas to create the "Career Development Program on Safety for Frozen Foods". Developing "safe food" requires the development of a systematic approach encompasses all aspects of food production such as training, harvest, processing, circulation, and sale of crops. This program nurtures and develops talented, internationally-minded people with a working command of Japanese language and business culture with strong managerial skills and a deep understanding of management philosophy.

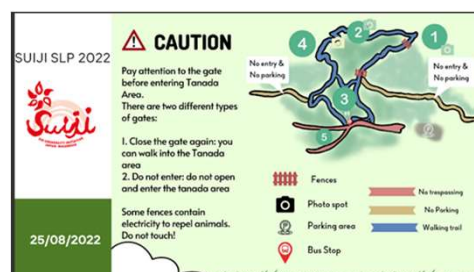

SPECIAL INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS (1)

Six University Initiative Japan Indonesia (SUIJI) Program International Service Learning Program

Domestic service-learning program Kagawa University formed the SUIJI (Six-University Initiative Japan Indonesia) consortium between six Japanese and Indonesian universities (Ehime University, Kagawa University, Kochi University, Gadjah Mada University, Bogor Agricultural University, and Hasanuddin University). We are developing multi-layered joint education programs from undergraduate to graduate school. In 2022, the Domestic Service Learning Program was held for 10 days from August 16th to 25th. 4 Kagawa University students, 6 Indonesian students (2 each from IPB, UGM, and UNHAS) and 3 Kagawa University SUIJI experience support students collaborated well through five days of local activities in Shodoshima Nakayama area and discussions in Takamatsu. I was able to work on it. In the activities on Shodoshima, problems in the Nakayama area were explored through walking surveys (jalan jaran) centered on the rice terraces and discussions with residents of the Nakayama area. Rather than a walking map for tourists, we created a terraced rice field map that is useful for preserving the terraced rice fields as a living space for the residents of the Nakayama area. SUIJI's purpose of getting involved in the community, improving communication skills, and proposing solutions to problems was fully accomplished. On the 25th, the final day, we were able to give a presentation in English, summarizing our activities. It was 10 days that pursued a real experience while incorporating online. Despite the various restrictions, we were able to devise ways to organize exchanges and activities that the SUIJI participants could enjoy. In addition, on September 10th, we held a joint online presentation and discussion session with 6 universities with 53 participants, which was a great success.



SPECIAL INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS (1)

Six University Initiative Japan Indonesia (SUIJI) Program International Service Learning Program

Overseas Service Learning Program Kagawa University formed the SUIJI (Six-University Initiative Japan Indonesia) consortium between six Japanese and Indonesian universities (Ehime University, Kagawa University, Kochi University, Gadjah Mada University, Bogor Agricultural University, and Hasanuddin University). We are developing multi-layered joint education programs from undergraduate to graduate school. In 2023, the Overseas Service Learning Program was held for 15 days from February 25th to March 10th. A total of 27 students from Kagawa University, Ehime University, and Kochi University (5 students from Kagawa University) participated in the event. They left Japan on February 25, 2023 and arrived in Jakarta, Indonesia the next morning. From here, we divided into three sites (Chiburao, Imogiri, and Toraja) and started activities. All of the sites were local activities on the 7th and 8th, but the participants energetically ran around tea farms, coffee farms, fruit and vegetable farms, and tourist sites in the rain, and had a good time sleeping and eating with Indonesian students. We did it together. Then, we interacted with local residents and discussed problems and issues (life improvement, elementary and junior high school education, health management, etc.) at the local site. When we gathered at Jakarta Airport on March 10th to return to Japan, everyone had a fearless look, probably because they had a little sunburn. I feel that SUIJI's purpose of getting involved in the community, improving communication skills, and proposing solutions to problems has been fully accomplished. Due to the short number of days of activities and more time spent on activities at the local site, we were not able to hold a joint presentation for the three sites in Indonesia, but after returning to Japan, we held a joint presentation for the six universities online. bottom.



SPECIAL INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMS (2)

Exchange Program of Science for youth (SAKURA Science Exchange Program: Short Stay for Young International Scientists)

Supported by Japan Science and Technology Agency (JST)

Exchange Program of Science for youth (SAKURA Science Exchange Program: Short Stay for Young International Scientists), aims to deepen exchange in the field of science and technology among Asian and Japanese Scientists. International researchers were invited to the Faculty of Agriculture to participate in this one-week program. They participated in special studies about issues related to the food industry and conducted research and experiments in the laboratory and special research facilities.

They also had the opportunity to experience Japanese food culture, and Japanese traditional food manufacturing methods.

International Exchange and Educational Program for Food Safety Short Visit (SV) Program for Undergraduate Japanese Students (Supported by Kagawa University and JASSO)

The Short Visit Program 2023 at Vietnam was successfully conducted in Hanoi, Vietnam from August 25th to September 28th, 2023. 12 students from the Faculty of Agriculture of Kagawa University participated this program. They were divided into 6 laboratories and engaged in research at Hanoi University of Science and Technology (HUST). In addition, they took classes related to agriculture together with HUST students and visited some food factories and food cultivation sites to learn about the actual processing of food products in Vietnam. Furthermore, they enjoyed cultural exchange with each other with HUST students. Through this international internship, the English communication skills of the students improved dramatically.
